ITINERARY Food and Drink

Take your customer's tastebuds on a self drive tour of England's Great West Way. Combine food and drink highlights with a selection of famous sights.

Arrive Windsor

Overnight: The new **Langley Hotel** and luxury Spa, just 9 miles from Windsor opened 2018.

Day 1. Windsor and Eton

Walk the Long Walk in Windsor Great Park, where the Duke & Duchess of Sussex drove after their royal wedding, to the Royal Farms Windsor Farm Shop. Buy a picnic from the deli counter with produce grown on the royal estates. Visit Windsor Castle (TIP: the queues aren't so long in the afternoon) and shopping in Royal Windsor Shopping Centre, once the Queen's personal railway station. Overnight: Macdonald Compleat Angler, on the banks of the river Thames in Marlow has the award-winning Riverside Restaurant (two AA rosettes).

Day 2. Vineyard and Breweries

Explore the Georgian town of Marlow before driving to the **Chiltern Valley Winery and Brewery** for a tour and tasting. Nearby **Stonor**, has been the family home for over 850 years. A light lunch is available in The Pantry, located in the 13th Century Hall. After a drive through the English countryside with stunning views, check in at the Royal Oak, before a short walk to **West Berkshire Brewery** for a tour and pre-dinner drink in the taproom.

Overnight: Royal Oak, Yattendon, a country inn with traditional British food (coincide a stay with a drinks festival).

Day 3. Beer and Gin...

Start at Donnington Castle Gatehouse (EH), Henry VIII and Elizabeth I are reported to have stayed here. Take a detour off the route to Bombay Sapphire Gin Distillery for a Cocktail Masterclass. Then drive to Wadworth Brewery & Visitor Centre at Devizes for a tour and tasting. If there's time, visit Devizes Wharf and Caen Hill Locks.

Overnight: Buttle Farm, Near Calne in a stunning barn conversion (self catering, min stay 2 nights) or **Doubletree by Hilton**, Swindon.

Day 4. Shopping, Railways and Pigs...

The grade II listed Great Western Railway works at Swindon are home to **McArthur Glen Designer** Outlet and the **STEAM Museum**, of **The Great Western Railway**. Then return to Buttle Farm for a tour and charcuterie lesson.

Overnight: Night 2 at Buttle Farm or the 17th century **Best** Western Plus Angel Hotel.

Day 5. Enjoy an epicurean experience

Start with a City Bus Tour with **Bath Bus Company**, followed by a foodie tour with **Savouring Bath**, introduces the top food & drink hot spots - tastings included! Buy a Museums Saver ticket to explore the





Fashion Museum Bath, the Roman Baths and Victoria Art Gallery! Overnight: The Royal Crescent Hotel & Spa, Bath. Dine in the three AA Rosette, The Dower House. Guests can unwind in the Spa & Bath House before dinner.
